**BEAUFORT MEMORIAL HOSTS “CYCLING SUNDAY” EVENT ON APRIL 27**  
*Bike rodeo and family fun ride to kick off 2008 Beaufort Memorial Cycling Classic*

BEAUFORT, S.C. – A bike safety rodeo and bike fittings are just a couple of many activities families can enjoy during “Cycling Sunday,” a free event to promote cycling safety scheduled for Sunday, April 27, from 2 to 5 p.m. in the annex on the main campus of Beaufort Memorial Hospital.

Cycling Sunday will serve as the official kick-off event for the second annual Beaufort Memorial Cycling Classic, a criterium-format professional cycling event to be held in downtown Beaufort on Tuesday, April 29. Beaufort Memorial is the presenting sponsor of the event.

Event registration begins at 2 p.m. and will be followed by helmet and bike fittings provided by BMH Outpatient Rehabilitation and Lowcountry Velo cycling club, and a bike safety rodeo. Following the rodeo, local and pro cyclists will lead a 45-minute family fun ride through Mossy Oaks that will end at the hospital.

Cycling Sunday is a free event open to children ages three and up, and adults of all ages. Each participant will receive a free bike helmet, tire reflectors, and other Beaufort Memorial Cycling Classic goodies. Everyone who successfully completes the bike safety rodeo will receive a certificate of completion, and will be entered in a drawing to win one of two free bicycles, courtesy of Lowcountry Bicycles.
