

SC Film Office Funding Solutions Panel Discussions

The South Carolina Film Commission will be making a presentation about the Film Production Fund, a grant program promoting collaboration between South Carolina students and independent producers at the Beaufort Film Festival on March 6.

A panel discussion and sneak preview of the 2007 grant winners will be from 2 to 4 pm on Thursday March 6 at the Arts Council of Beaufort County Performance Center on Boundary Street. The producers of *The Four Children of Tander Welch* and *The Song of Pumpkin Brown* will be on hand to discuss their projects and the Production Fund. *The Four Children of Tander Welch* is a finalist in the Beaufort Film Festival and will be shown for the first time in its entirety on Friday March 7th at 7pm at the Lady's Island Cinema

The Beaufort Kaleidoscope: Film, Food and Fine Art, March, 6-9, 2008 is presented by the Beaufort Regional Chamber of Commerce.

The mission of the Beaufort Film Festival is to enliven the community by fostering and developing a rich appreciation for the art of filmmaking. For the past quarter of a century Beaufort has served as the backdrop for more than 20 major motion pictures, including *Forrest Gump*, *The Big Chill*, *The Prince of Tides*, and many more.
